8. Adoption of New Jersey Quality Single Accountability Continuum (NJQSAC) Statement of Assurance 2014-2015

- 1. The Department of Guidance has added twenty-three (23) counselors throughout the district, including guidance counselors and school-based social workers. All school-based social workers and guidance counselors received five (5) hours of professional development on Interventions and Referral Services (I&RS). The workshop focused on addressing academic, behavior interventions and developing effective strategies to assist students who are experiencing learning, behavior or health needs. All schools in the district have an I&RS Team assigned.
- 2. In September of 2014, all child study team members received five (5) hours of professional development on an examination of their own IEP's. The workshop focused on reviewing their current practices from referrals to declassification.
- 3. Additionally, throughout the 2014-2015 school year, professional development on observable and measurable starting lines to prevent or classify, measuring I&RS cases (what and how CST members are measuring in rejecting and or accepting cases), and changing past practices (resistance vs. new practices) will be given to all child study team members.
