Department of Security

- Hired a Coordinator of Security
- Responsibilities include:
 - Examining security procedures and systems district-wide
 - Developing a Training Plan for Security Aides
 - Conducting an analysis to determine desired staffing at each building



Department of Security

- Provides leadership to develop and evaluate security personnel
- Created a School Safety Task Force
- Conducts regular meetings with the School Safety Task Force
- Implemented security protocols at every school
- Conducts continuous assessments of security systems and monitors effective use of security equipment



Building Our Team

- Security Ratio 1 to 333
- Personnel
 - 18 School Resource Officers (SROs) through our Shared Service Agreement
 - 41 Total Security Aides
 - Since 2014 Added 26 Security Aide positions:
 - 2014-2015 13 Security Aide positions
 - 2015-2016 13 Security Aide Positions
 - New Uniforms



Training

- Training scheduled for February on metal detectors for principals and security aides

Equipping Schools

- Purchased Two-way radios for security personnel

- Purchased metal detector wands for all schools
- Purchased new uniforms for security aides
- Established a district-wide radio security channel
- Reprogramed existing and 133 new two-way radios throughout the district
