

Policy

TUITION INCOME

The Passaic Board of Education shall charge and assess tuition for attendance in the schools of this district by students not entitled to receive a free public education in this district and whose enrollment has been approved by the board.

Tuition rates will be determined and approved annually and will represent the cost per student in average daily enrollment, in accordance with law. Rates will be published to the sender before the beginning of the school year or before the student's attendance commences.

The School Business Administrator/Board Secretary shall be responsible for the assessment and collection of tuition. Tuition billing will be made annually in advance of the period for which the billing is made and collected on a monthly basis. A student who attends more than one half in any billing period of a month will be charged for the full period.

Educational services will be terminated for any student whose tuition payment is more than 60 days overdue for a school district and 30 days overdue for individuals.
