

**Regulation**

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PUBLIC PERFORMANCES AND EXHIBITIONS

Participation

All requests for public performances or participation by Passaic students shall be approved initially by the principal who shall then forward the request to the superintendent or his/her designee for final approval. There shall be no preparation for the performance or the student participation until superintendent's or his/her designee's approval has been received.

When the performance is requested by an organization not connected with the schools, the organization shall pay all expenses unless specific costs are waived by the board upon recommendation of the Superintendent.

Permission slips shall be sent to the parents/guardians for approval of the student's participation. Signed permission slips must be received prior to the student's participation.

Approval of Content

Building principals shall, in advance of preparation of the students:

- A. Review all program materials and offerings to ensure that the material has value to the educational program;
- B. Ensure that the presentation will not be controversial. If there is a question as to whether or not the presentation may cause controversy, the information on the presentation shall be forwarded to the Superintendent or his/her designee, and if necessary, to the board to determine whether there will be district participation.
