SOCIAL EVENTS/MEETINGS

Social activities in school life assist students in learning how to enjoy worthwhile group events, how to conduct them, and how to contribute to the enjoyment of others. Therefore, school groups and classes may hold social events for their membership with proper authorization and under staff supervision, using school facilities.

No social function shall be held on school property, or be promoted as being a school-related function, without prior authorization by the Superintendent or his/her designee.

The principal and the teaching staff shall evaluate social events in terms of contributions to student growth and morale, and shall develop procedures for scheduling and conducting such events, including proper chaperonage.
