

INSTRUCTIONAL ARRANGEMENTS

Instructional arrangements, including assignment of students to teachers, programs, and classes, provisions for specialized classes and for interdisciplinary and interclass activities, shall all be designed with the purpose of providing optimum benefit to students and accommodating their diverse learning styles and of best utilization of district resources.

The school principal is responsible for assigning and scheduling students within a school. The school principal may assign students in his or her school to grades, classes, and groups on the basis of the needs of the students as well as the sound administration of the school.

The individual school principal shall have authority to review and decide any requests for change of assignment or placement of students. Parents may appeal the assignment of their child to the Superintendent or his/her designee after a conference with and decision by the school principal.
