Dear School 17 Community,

I am writing you to share some exciting news. The New Jersey Schools Development Authority (NJSDA) has agreed to begin construction on the Dayton Avenue Education Complex, investing \$210 million to build four new schools to support more than 2,700 Passaic students! This tremendous investment in our infrastructure will support our vision to become the best urban school system in the State of New Jersey.

In order for the NJSDA to begin the construction process, the Passaic School Board approved, at the June 6, 2017 board meeting, to close School No. 17 effective July 1, 2017. Action was also taken to adjust the attendance zones near and around School No. 17. Pre-K through Grade 1 students currently attending School No. 17 will be advised of their new school assignment by the end of the school year. In addition, the district is working closely with the NJSDA to identify additional temporary classrooms at locations throughout the district to accommodate necessary programming shifts.

Your child's school assignment for the 2017-2018 school year will be shared prior to the last day of school, and included in the final report card.
