**7432 - EYE PROTECTION PRACTICES (Regulation)**

**M**

**A. Eye protection devices**

1. The following types of eye protective devices must be worn by all pupils, staff members, and visitors (including persons attending evening adult school programs) participating in the activity or process designated wherever it may occur on school premises:

Potential eye hazard	Protective devices
Caustic or explosive materials	Goggle, flexible fitting, hooded ventilation; add plastic window face shield for severe exposure
Dust producing	Goggle, flexible fitting, hooded ventilation
Electric arc welding operations	Welding helmet in combination with spectacles with eye cup or semi- or flat-fold side shields
Oxy-acetylene welding	Welding goggle, eye cup type with tinted lenses; welding goggle, coverspec type with tinted lenses or tinted plate lens
Hot liquids and gases	Goggle, flexible fitting, hood ventilation; add plastic window face shield for severe exposure

Hot solids	Clear or tinted goggles or spectacles with side shields
Molten materials	Clear or tinted goggles and plastic or mesh window face shield
Heat treatment or tempering	Clear or tinted goggles or clear or tinted spectacles with side shields
Glare operations	Tinted goggles; tinted spectacles with side shields or welding goggles, eye cup or coverage type with tinted lenses or plate lens
Shaping solid materials	Clear goggles, flexible or rigid body; clear spectacles with side shields; add plastic window face shield for severe exposure
Laser device operation or experimentation	Appropriate for specific hazard
Repair or servicing of vehicles	Clear goggles, flexible or rigid body; clear spectacles with side shields
Other potentially eye hazardous processes or activities	Appropriate for specific hazard

2. The supplier of any eye protective device to this district shall certify in writing that the device meets or exceeds ANSI standards. All spectacle type eye protective devices shall have side shields of the eye cup, semi-, or flat-fold type.





















## Responsibility of Custodians

1. Custodians represent the Board of Education and are to execute all policies, rules, and regulations while the facility is being used.
2. Custodians are to make certain no damage occurs; they may request through security personnel that unruly people are to vacate the premises and may notify the police if assistance is needed.
3. Custodians may not issue keys to the user organization.
4. Custodians must complete the Custodian Report to the Board of Education concerning the organization's use of the facility.

The Board of Education reserves the right to deny future use of school facilities to any group who violates the "Use of School Facilities" regulations.

These rental fees are separate of any direct custodial labor and utility fees. All fees will be billed to the user group by the Business Office following the event. All checks and/or money orders are to be made out to the Passaic Board of Education.

### Limitations of Use-Passaic Stadium

The Board of Education deems it necessary to have the Passaic Stadium grounds and fields to be in the best condition for the many school sponsored athletic competitions, games, meets and matches. With this in mind, the Board will strictly limit the use of the Stadium to non-profit groups.
